Who can Apply?

Graduating Manitoba high school students currently enrolled in their final year and who will be enrolled full-time in a degree or diploma program at a recognized publicly funded Canadian university or college in the Fall 2018 academic term.

All applicants must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents with a ***minimum 70% average in their last completed year of study.***
